This Privacy Policy applies to information collected through our website and general online services. If you become a patient of REV0lution, your Protected Health Information (PHI) is governed by our HIPAA Notice of Privacy Practices, which supplements this Privacy Policy.

## Information We Collect

## How We Use Information

We may use your information to:

## Cookies and Website Tracking

## How We Share Information

We do not sell your personal information. We may share information with trusted third-party service providers who help us operate our website, process payments, deliver emails, manage scheduling, provide technology services, or support business operations. These service providers are authorized to use your information only as necessary to perform services on our behalf and are expected to maintain appropriate privacy and security protections. We may also disclose information when required by law, legal process, regulation, court order, or to protect our rights, safety, property, users, or others.

## Security
